The project was implemented by the Research Institute PROMITHEAS, in collaboration with KIIF and the University of Cyprus. The project was funded by the Cyprus Research and Innovation Foundation. KIIF, in collaboration with the <u>Centre for Social Innovation (CSI)</u>, the <u>Conexus Association</u> from Spain and the <u>Global Alliance for LGBT Education (GALE)</u> from the Netherlands, have created an <u>online platform</u> with educational material and lesson plans on gender and equality issues. The material was developed to be used by educators /trainers and instructors/facilitators. It targets the educational needs of adolescents, especially boys, aged 15–17 years old. It can also be used for mixed-gender groups. The platform includes a <u>Facilitator's Guide and Curriculum</u> as well as an online interactive <u>Workbook for Participants</u> where participants and students can login and find the activities/material they will need during the implementation of the courses. The project was funded by the European Program ERASMUS+.

The project was funded by the <u>Youth Board of Cyprus</u>, under the program "ReCOVer20". The aim of the project was to examine the experiences and needs of young immigrant women living in Cyprus in regard to the pandemic and its consequences.

Public Dialogue - The Youth for Gender Equality in the Family: The Importance of the State and the Social Institutions

KIIF in cooperation with the <u>Cyprus Family Planning Association (KSOP)</u> implemented the structured dialogue project "<u>Young people for gender equality in the family: The importance of the state and social institutions</u>" which was funded by the European Program ERASMUS+. The project aimed at promoting dialogue, and educating and empowering the participants to codevelop policy recommendations regarding gender equality in the family. At the end of the project, a series of meetings between representatives of the youth group with stakeholders and officials were held. There, the participants distributed <u>the project booklet</u> which summarized the results of the research and the workshops. The booklet concludes with a list of policy recommendations formulated by the youth group.
